



Inclement Weather Plan of Action

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Occasionally it is necessary to cancel the After School Program for the safety of the students when weather conditions take a turn for the worse. When programs have to be canceled there is always an announcement at the school so your child is aware.

In addition to school day announcements, calls are made home by an automated system (Call Multiplier) to parents using the numbers you specified on the After School Program Enrollment Form when you signed up your child. It is important to keep this contact information up to date, so please call with any changes. Along with listing your specified emergency numbers, you instructed staff as to whether your child would be picked up, walk, or ride the bus home in the event of a cancelation to ensure that your child gets home safely with as little confusion as possible. It is important to discuss this arrangement with your child for their peace of mind and knowledge of what to do when they hear the announcement of cancelation.

The Site Director will make every possible effort to be on hand to direct students in the event that they forget what they are supposed to do when program is canceled. Therefore, if emergency plans have changed, please call your Site Director with instructions.

****Please refrain from calling the school,** unless absolutely necessary, to reduce the impact cancelations have on school day personnel. School offices are very busy with calls and day-to-day traffic, and an increase in call volume slows down efficiency.
